#### **Challenge**

Primavera Online School seeks to provide students with engaging career education coursework that supports their mission of inspiring students to reach their full potential through innovative and customized learning.

### Solution \$\text{\$\text{\$\text{\$}}} \]

An 18-week pilot consisting of three 6-week sessions to gather student feedback. Registration for select courses (Robotics: Applications and Careers, and Esports and the History of Gaming) was open to all Primavera students who choose CTE eCourses as an elective offering. Students selected courses independently and/or worked with a guidance or enrollment counselor to determine if these courses were in line with their goals.

#### Outcome

A total of 334 students participated in the Pilot that Primavera Online School offered during the Spring 2020 term. Students taking an end-of-course survey rated, on average, CTE eCourses a 4.35 on a 5-point scale.
